Eligibility

- PhD Research Project exploring topics related to Making European Society
- Research project fully integrated in one of MAKerS areas / lines of research
- Thesis supervision conducted by a member of ITI-MAKERs
- Thesis joint supervision (2 scientific disciplines) is welcome
- Applicants must hold a M2 Degree in political science, law, sociology, or economics ... or must be graduated during the current academic year

Application Process

Please make sure that all the documents are complete and in due form.

All documents must be submitted before the closing date and time of the call.

Documents must be transmitted to iti-makers@unistra.fr in a single folder (name-firstname.zip) indicating at the beginning of each of the documents the name and first name of the eligible candidate.

Documents to be provided (in specified name and format files):

- CV (CV-name-firstname.pdf)
- M2 Master thesis (Master-name-firstname.pdf)
- M2 official transcript (Transcript-name-firstname.pdf)
- Application form with PhD research project (Form-name-firstname.pdf)

Evaluation of proposals

Only complete files, received on time, will be reviewed.

Evaluation criteria of application files:

- Quality of the research project
- PhD Research Project developing interdisciplinary approaches in political science, law, sociology, economics, science history, geography would be very much appreciated
- Particular attention will be paid to Data analysis and treatment

Interview will take place online on Friday 30th June 2023

- oral presentation: 10 minutes (Powerpoint presentation allowed)
- discussion with the Research Commission members: 10 minutes

Evaluation criteria of the interview

- Quality of the oral presentation
- Quality of the discussion with the members of the selection committee

Results will be published on 4th July 2023.
