


Candidates are invited to contact MAKerS research axis managers before application.

Eligibility

- You have a PhD in either political science, economics, law, science history, sociology, or geography.
- Your PhD defense occurred after 1st January 2021 and before 9th June 2023
- Your research proposal explores topics related to the main line of MAKerS research: 'Making European Society'
- It is fully integrated in one MAKerS research axis
- Your research proposal develops interdisciplinary approaches in political science, law, sociology, economics, science history, or geography
- Proposal is in French or in English language.

Good knowledge of French language is not required but recommended. Fellows can undertake intensive course of French at the beginning of their stay.

Application Process

Please make sure that all the documents are complete and in due form with your name and first name on top of each document.

All documents must be submitted before the closing date and time of the call.

Documents must be transmitted to iti-makers@unistra.fr in a single folder (name-firstname.zip).

Documents to be provided :

- Application Form with research proposal (Form-name-firstname.pdf)
- Detailed CV (CV-name-firstname.pdf)
- Publications list (listP-name-firstname.pdf)
- 1 publication (in French or English language) (Publi-name-firstname.pdf)
- Thesis Summary (1 page) (Summary-name-firstname.pdf)
- Doctoral thesis (Thesis-name-firstname.pdf)
- (Pre)-Defense report (Report-name-firstname.pdf)

Evaluation of proposals

Only complete files, received on time, will be reviewed.

Evaluation criteria of the application:

- Quality of the research project
- Interdisciplinarity relevance
- Appropriateness with MAKerS objectives
- Special attention will be paid to Data analysis and collection

Candidates short-listed will receive an electronic invitation to attend an interview.

Interview in French or English will take place online on Friday 30th June 2023

- oral presentation: 10 minutes – Powerpoint presentation allowed
- discussion with the Research Commission members: 20 minutes

Evaluation criteria of the interview:

- Quality of the oral presentation
- Quality of the discussion with the selection committee members

Results will be published on 4th July 2023
