- Your PhD defense occurred after 1st January 2023 and before 13 June 2025
- Your research proposal explores topics related to the main line of MAKErS research: 'Making European Society'
- It is fully integrated in one MAKErS research axis
- Your research proposal develops interdisciplinary approaches in political science, law, sociology, economics, science history, or geography
- Proposal is in French or in English language.

Good knowledge of French language is not required but recommended. Fellows can undertake intensive course of French at the beginning of their stay.

Candidates short-listed will receive an electronic invitation to attend an interview. Interview in French or English will take place online on Monday 30 June 2025.
